The main aims and objectives of the organisation are as follows:

- To create an opportunity for people of all ages to participate in a community activity whilst promoting the use of the Welsh language in an inclusive setting within Caerphilly County Borough.
- To strengthen the community's cultural and linguistic identity by encouraging participation by Welsh speakers. Welsh learners and non-Welsh speakers.
- To encourage a varied cross section of people from within the Caerphilly County Borough to assist in the organisation and management of the event.

The annual Eisteddfod provides an additional community platform outside the local school setting to promote Welsh language and culture to the residents of the area. In these difficult economic times, it is important that we encourage local performing arts by providing an opportunity for them to be staged before an enthusiastic and supportive community made up of families and relatives, friends, neighbours and general community supporters

#### 4. MEMBERSHIP OF ORGANISATION/OR BENEFICIARIES OF ACTIVITIES:

It is not a membership organisation. The beneficiaries of the activities include:

- Competitors: Many of the Eisteddfod's competitions are aimed at school age children, both primary and secondary. Ysgol y Castell, Ysgol Gynradd Caerffili and Ysgol Cwm Rhymni regularly participate and will be actively encouraged to support again this year, particularly as the Eisteddfod is being held in the town. English medium schools will also be contacted to encourage their involvement as will be local choirs, individuals and cultural groups

- Audience: the event will be marketed locally as an evening of Welsh culture, with the aim of providing an evening's entertainment whilst promoting the Welsh language and culture in Caerphilly Town

The organisation's financial position at the end of December 2015 is attached.

The organization is self-funding through grants and donations as well as entry fee to the event. This is kept low at £3 per adult (children free) in order to ensure inclusivity.

Requests have gone out to all community councils within the Borough for support. A local fundraising concert arranged by the organization raised £250. Further grants, donations and sponsorship are also actively being sought from local businesses

#### 6. PURPOSE FOR WHICH ASSISTANCE IS REQUIRED AND ESTMATES OF COSTS:

The annual event costs around £1,500 to stage each year with costs including prize money, advertising, venue hire and administrative costs. Financial assistance is requested towards these costs to ensure the continued viability of the Eisteddfod and to enable the entry fees to be kept at a reasonable level in order to attract a wide audience

The Eisteddfod is celebrating its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year. Our aim is to relaunch the event, building on past success while modernizing competitions and activities to appeal to a wider range of people.

The relaunch will involve developing a new logo and branding to represent the area, new modern competitions geared towards today's young people and active use of social media in order to further raise the profile and reach of the event

The event will move to Ysgol y Gwyndy, Caerphilly in order to provide better facilities and amenities to participants and attendees
