50. MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 15TH SEPTEMBER 2014

Minutes of the Ordinary Council Meeting held on 15th September 2014 were received, confirmed and signed subject to the address in 44e being removed.

51. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

No matters arising from the minutes.

52. COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY

Lisa James gave a presentation on the introduction of the Community Infrastructure Levy (C.I.L.) (extensions over 100 sqr metres). C.I.L. is a tax on new development to be paid by the developer, which came into effect from 1st July 2014. It is a levy based on square metre. The rate for Caerphilly (residential) is £40 a square metre. Social housing and self build is exempt from C.I.L.

The Borough must pass 15% subject to £100 maximum per property to the Town Council. C.I.L. payments will meet the infrastructure costs but not the maintenance. It is hoped payments will be made annually at the end of June.

Anything not spent within 5 years must be returned to the borough. The borough can part fund any project by putting some of its 85% towards the cost of the project.

Two copies of the Local Development Plans up to 2021 was left for members.

53. COMMUNITY SAFETY MATTERS

Inspector Jones attended the meeting.

Burglary, car crime and garage breakings are ongoing. Operation Resolute will hopefully result in culprits being apprehended.

Anti Social Behaviour in town centre have been brought to the attention of police. There are predominantly 3 offenders who have been previously charged with offences. The process of issuing ASBO's is ongoing with these individuals.

Thursday evening 6.30 p.m. to 7.30 p.m. at the Fire Station, Caerphilly, each ward will present on the work officers are doing in the town. Paul Jackson from the Fire Arms Unit based in Rumney, will be speaking at the meeting together with an officer from Operation Resolute.

Crossroads White Street/Bartlett Street, vehicles seen going the wrong way down Bartlett Street.

Land behind Tescos and Co-op Bank with cars parking blocking off access. It was agreed to write to shops asking if they will keep area clear.

Gangs of youths using the side streets causing problems.

Rough sleeper at junction of Park Lane/Crescent Road by Elim Pentacostal Church.

Gentleman suffering from Parkinson's disease seen around the town asking for money.

Blackberry number to be forwarded to Clerk.

56. PROJECTS AND TOWN CLERK'S REPORT

Councillors P. Bevan and Jenny Hibbert declared an interest and took no part in the discussions or decision making.

a. Partnership Proposals from Urdd Eisteddfod

Members considered the partnership proposals submitted by the Urdd Eisteddfod. After debating the proposals it was duly proposed and seconded to make a donation of £2,500 this financial year and £2,500 next financial year.

An amendment to make a donation of £5,000 this financial year and £5,000 for next financial year was proposed and seconded with options 4 and 5, i.e. Sponsor the Primary School Musical Show and Sponsor a Main Ceremony of the day was put forward.

Members voted on the two motions and there was 4 votes for and 4 votes against both the proposal and amendment. The Town Mayor, Councillor J. Fussell used his casting vote in favour of the amendment i.e., a donation of £5,000 for the current financial year and £5,000 for the next financial year.

b. <u>Concessionary Use of Caerphilly Castle</u>

An application for a concessionary use of Caerphilly Castle by the Stroke Association was considered by members who agreed to the concessionary use.

c. <u>Caerphilly Open Art Competition 2014/15</u>

Members considered the request to sponsor this year's event and agreed to make a donation of £1,050 to support the competition.

d. Public Engagement on Town Council Budget

Following a request at the previous Council Meeting a report on involving the public in determining how the Town Council spent its budget was discussed by members.

The clerk reported that all council papers are displayed on the website at the same time they are sent to members a week before the meeting takes place.

When the revenue estimates are placed before Council for consideration they will also be on the website which members of the public can access.

Members debated at length the best way to involve the public and agreed to the following.

- 1) A Public consultation exercise will be considered for items of expenditure in excess of £15,000.
- 2) It was agreed to request the County Borough to change the website to include a suggestion/comment page where peoples views can be collected and brought back to members.
- The clerk was asked to find out the cost of a press release detailing next year's revenue estimates in the Campaign and Caerphilly Observer.
- 4) A suggestion to vary meeting venues was made but no decision made.

e. Location of Grit Bins

The report was accepted by members although they expressed their displeasure with the information supplied by officers of the Borough Council.

Borough Councillors can ring the Highways Department and request a supply of grit be deposited at designated locations.

Public Consultation

At the last Council meeting members discussed the possibility of consulting the public before agreeing major items of expenditure.

A request has been made to the Borough Council to amend the Town Council website to allow a suggestion/comments page and possibly an on line survey.

The Caerphilly Observer and Campaign have also been contacted about costs of placing an article in them.

The Caerphilly Observer will run a story free of charge and the Campaign charge £280 for a quarter page advert.

Looked After Children

Every year an achievement award event for Caerphilly Looked After Children is held. These events are divided into primary age children and secondary age and care leaders.

A request has been received for a concessionary use of Caerphilly Castle next February to hold the award event for the secondary age and care leaders group. It is hoped 200 young people, guests and staff will attend the event.

Two concessions have been granted which leaves 4 more available for 2015.

Members are asked to decide if a concession should be granted and if the hire charge should be met by the Council.

I write to confirm I have been advised the proposed removal of the funding outlined in my letter of the 10th, will now not occur in 2015/16. Therefore, I have been advised to progress the displays for a further one year at Caerphilly.

As I have discussed the removal of displays with your clerk since my letter, we will, as requested, draw up a draft programme of floral displays covering the main popular areas in Caerphilly during the coming year for your member's considerations. This draft programme of displays will be based on this coming season's price from our suppliers and water contractor.

I would also confirm the Area Parks Officer is actively pursuing new sponsorship from businesses etc. to provide displays; this is in addition to other groups already committed to sponsoring displays in and around the retail areas of the town.

Our procurement arrangements covering the purchase of the plants, displays and watering arrangements are to be extended for a further year; as such we anticipate our costs will increase for this one year extension (2015). We plan to cover this increase in costs by a small reduction in the number of displays provided in the past.


