### Council Precept 2017/2018/ Band D Charge 2017/2018

At last month's meeting members agreed the Revenue Estimates for 2017/2018 with a deficit of £9,890. This included one off payments of £9,000 for Election Costs and the Gratuity Scheme.

The precept included in the estimates was £80,000 based on a Band D Council Tax of £13.00.

The provisional number of Band D properties supplied by the Caerphilly County Borough Council for 2017/2018 is 6159.77 which will raise a precept of £80,077.01 if members agree to keep the council tax for Band D properties at £13.00.

Members are asked to consider this report and to determine the Band D Council Tax for 2017/2018.

### Fireworks Collection 2016

The fireworks collection for this year's Town Mayor's charities amounted to £6,835.18.

The two charities to benefit from the collection will be Caerffili Lions and Wales Air Ambulance.
