Caerffili In Bloom First Place! Safle Gyntaf i Gaerffili yn ei Blodau!

Caerphilly enjoyed more success at the 2022 Wales in Bloom competition, clinching first place and a gold award in the Town Centre category. The competition was held in Talgarth in Powys after judging took place in the town in July. It also followed on from success in 2021 when Caerphilly clinched first place beating Penarth to the top spot.

It is the first time Caerphilly has ever won a gold award at the annual event. Funded by Caerphilly Town Council with other grants won by the Caerffili in Bloom Group, the competition sees the town centre decorated with plant troughs and hanging baskets during the Summer months. Included in Caerphilly's entry were displays at Caerphilly railway station, Dafydd Williams Park, Coffi Vista and the Caerphilly Miners Centre.

Reacting to the win, Councillor James Fussell, who is Chair of Caerffili in Bloom said; "I am speechless and over the moon with winning Gold. It makes all the hard work and effort worthwhile."

Did you Know?

Owain Glyndwr, the last Prince of Wales, captured Caerffili Castle during his campaign to establish a Welsh state independent of the English Crown. He occupied the castle in 1403 for three months and again in 1405. Following the defeat of the Glyndwr's campaign the castle fell into decay.

Glyndwr is also noted for setting up the last Welsh parliament before the current Senedd was established this century.

Council Tax NO Change DIM Newid Cyngor Treth

For 2022/3 the Town Council held the precept at £15.50 for a Band D property. Almost everything the Town Council does is paid for by this precept on residents Council Tax. This equates to 30 pence a week for a Band D household.

The Town Council funds annual events including the Flower Festival, summer Floral Displays, a Firework Display, Christmas Lights, lantern parade and sponsors events organised by others.

Additional funding is secured through the Community Infrastructure Levy from building developments in the town. This is used towards specific projects and has included the Welsh National Anthem Memorial Sculpture and EV charge points at the Twyn.

Local voluntary groups are supported through the grants scheme. Full details and an application form can be found on the Town Council website.
